



INITIAL THOUGHTS

Firstly, a huge thankyou for taking the time to consider 'Sister Wives' in the short category at your awards. It really was a huge labour of love and dedication so it's great to share it with you!

As ever with short films, the budget was super tight and my entire art budget was £750. To create a time specific piece and also a country specific piece this was a struggle as you can imagine.

We got a gorgeous location which was perfect from the outside - but the inside was super mod with black shiny marble surfaces, black shiny black shelving, green walls everywhere and crushed velvet furniture/curtains - a very 'live, laugh, love' air bnb aesthetic.

To create this world on this small budget I spent a month on facebook marketplace - sourcing rocking chairs, an old wardrobe, bed frames and old fittings for free..... aswell as rinsing my nans old attic of extra dressing. I even found a copper bath in a barn i polished up!

When heading to shoot I had requested a build day as i had to wood vinyl every surface, carry the bath and wardrobe and also wallpaper the bedroom. I was allowed this but i unfortunately had to forfeit an assistant, but I had no choice - therefore on the 4 day shoot I was the only member of the entire art department making food, re-setting, dressing and propping!

All the trials included - I felt such a huge sense of achievement at the end of it and I'm so proud of what we created! Thanks again for taking the time to have a look at our little film!
