

The Wicked Little Letters script, for me, is a comic dark tale enveloped in an appealing British seaside postcard, Martin Parr aesthetic world. The design challenge was to represent the differences in the lives of the 2 characters through their immediate surroundings as a result of their own personal histories and societies expectations on them and the effect that the war was having on all of them.

I aimed to create a 1929's seaside town look using a pastels palette to represent the outside world that was drawn from Martin Parr and saucy seaside postcards comic aesthetic.

Using bits of Arundel and Worthing for our town, and building the cottages tiny interiors, shared backyards and washing area, bringing in the flint common in the Arundel area and building the cottages large enough to film in whilst keeping the sense of claustrophobia for the story.

I worked on taking the character's family back into the rigid late Victorian Era with all the wallpapers and furnishings, contrasting with the new youthful, loud, somewhat emotionally freer Jessie Buckley character.

I researched PTSD during WW1 and the devastating effect it was having on communities and families, I felt it important to include this in the design concept.

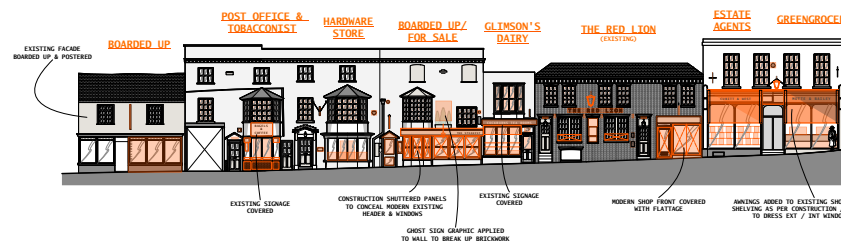


WICKED LITTLE LETTERS | EXT LITTLEHAMPTON HIGHSTREET | ARUNDEL HIGHSTREET | PLAN

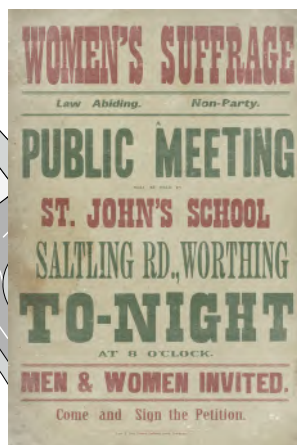
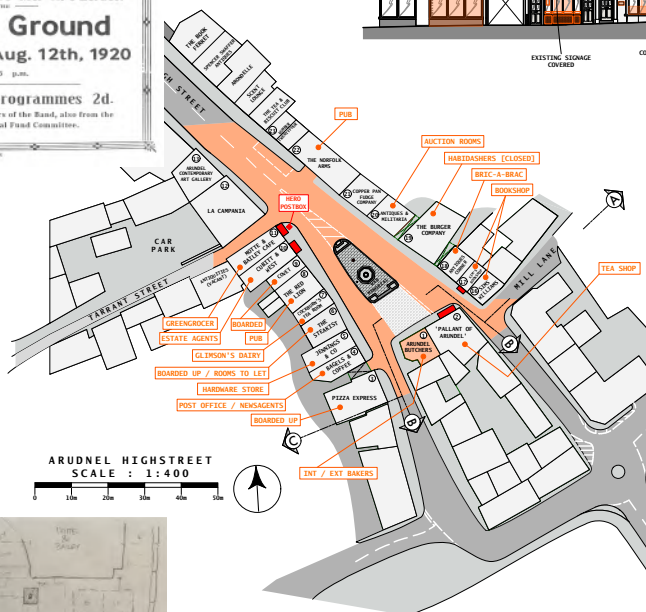

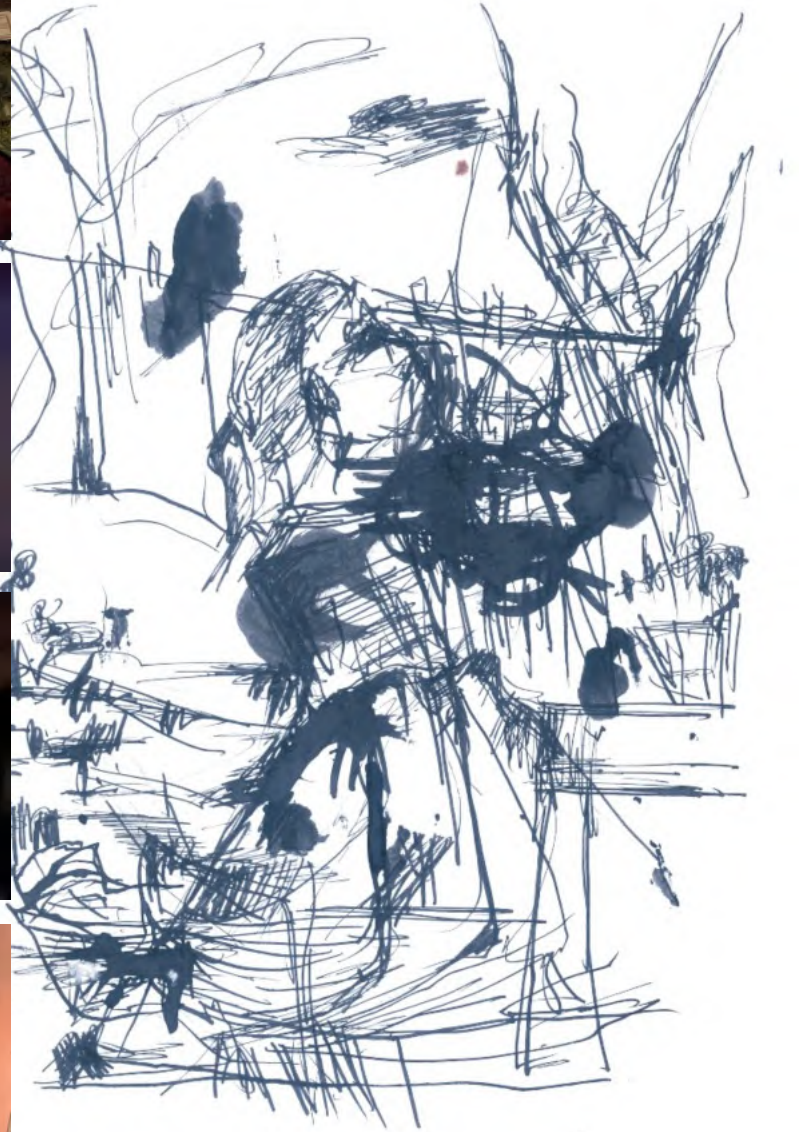


WICKED LITTLE LETTERS | INT. SWANS HOUSE - UPSTAIRS-BEDROOM // P&E // PINEWOOD STAGE
